Featured Speaker

Featured speaker for January meeting will be Dr. Hilt Tatum, Jr. Dr. Tatum is widely regarded as the world's most skilled and capable dental implant surgeon by many dentists knowledgeable in the history and development of implant dentistry.



His clinical skills are legendary. For nearly forty years there have been countless reports from Oral Surgeons, Periodontists, General Dentists, Prosthodontists, and students at all levels of competency, amazed by direct observation of his unmatched surgical and conceptual talents. Dr. Tatum's original contributions of bone grafting, sinus augmentation, bone expansion for thin ridges, implant design, clinical patient management, and sterile operating technique established the standards for the field of implant dentistry as the discipline matured.

Dr. Leonard Linkow became a dentist in 1952 after graduating from New York University College of Dentistry. For 30 years he has been a proponent of dental implants, working on creating the most advanced didactic, clinical and research discipline the world has ever known today. He is a clinical professor and has presented world-wide.

Dr. Mohamed Sharawy is Professor and Director of Oral Biology and Maxillofacial Pathology in the Medical College of Georgia School of Dentistry and Professor of Anatomy in the MCG School of Medicine.

Dr. Jack Lemons is a Professor of Dentistry in the Department of Prosthodontics at the UAB School of Dentistry. His interests include dental biomaterials, biological tissue reaction to synthetic materials and biomechanics. He has authored hundreds of publications and made more than 400 presentations and abstracts.

Dr. Walter Chitwood, Jr. graduated from University of Tennessee Center for the Health Sciences College of Dentistry and maintains a private practice in Implant and General Dentistry in Murfreesboro, TN.

Dr. Bart Johnson is Director of the General Practice Residency program at the University of Washington. He has a DDS and Master of Science in Oral Biology from UCLA. In the GPR program they see a wide range of transplant patients and other medically compromised patients.

Dr. Scott Ganz maintains a private practice in Fort Lee, NJ. He has delivered presentations both nationally and internationally on Implant Dentistry and has been considered America's leading expert in the evolution of interactive software applications for diagnosis and treatment planning, use of CT scans and the new Cone Beam CT scan imaging.

Dr. Michael Keenan received his DDS from Creighton University and maintains a private practice in Seattle WA. He is a member of the ADA, the Western Society of Periodontics, Oregon Implant Research Group and International Congress of Oral Implantology.

Dr. James Rutkowski practices general and implant dentistry in Clarion, PA. He is a dental courtesy staff member at Clarion Hospital pursuing his Ph.D in pharmacology and toxicology at Duquesne University.

***Dr. Hilt Tatum**, an Associate Professor in the Lille University Medical School, France, Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Implantology, is a Diplomate and past president of the American Board of Oral Implantology; past president of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry and Past Director of the Edward White Hospital Implant Residency Program.

Dr. William LaConte, maintains a Private Practice at the Southern Dental Implant Center in Cordova, is on the Multi-Maxi-Course® faculty, a Fellow of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry and a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry.
